### The Position

The Environmental Health Program at Vital Strategies is seeking qualified candidates for the position of **Environmental Health Research Assistant.** This is a full-time position based in New York City. Applicants must possess a valid work permit to work in New York City.

The ideal candidate for this position should be experienced in environmental health or a public health professional to serve as a full-time research assistant, supporting the development of reports, proposals and projects that address urban environmental problems of global public health significance. The research assistant will support the planning, development and evaluation of initiatives on subjects including but not limited to ambient and household air pollution, sustainable urban development, health impacts and mitigation of climate change, the control and consequences of environmental contamination, public health governance, and environmental health surveillance. Vital Strategies works internationally in low- and middle-income countries.

The Research Assistant will work directly with the Environmental Health Program leadership team and will have an opportunity to work with other senior public health experts at Vital Strategies and its partners.

Vital Strategies offers competitive compensation based on prior experience and qualifications as well as comprehensive benefits in order to best support our people.
