The Position

Vital Strategies is seeking qualified a candidate for the position of Country Coordinator, Data Impact. This position supports the Data Impact component of the Bloomberg Philanthropies Data for Health Initiative, which aims to enhance public health data use in low- and middle-income countries. Vital Strategies is seeking qualified candidates for consultancy assignment in Mumbai. The duration of the assignment will be for 12 months, with the possibility of contract renewal subject to performance and availability of funds

The Vital Strategies' Data Impact team works closely with the Public Health Departments of the Government of Maharasthra and the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai to provide capacity development in the domain of data use. Data Impact's program objective is to systematically strengthen the use of data in key decisions areas. The Country Coordinator will be the primary technical lead for the country and will be provided working space in one of the Public Health Departments. The Country Coordinator will report to a Vital Strategies technical country lead, based in New York.

Specific Duties

General Responsibilities

Working closely with the Vital Strategies country lead, the Country Coordinator will lead the successful development and implementation of a program of Technical Assistance mutually agreed upon by the Public Health Departments and Vital Strategies. The Country Coordinator will ensure that this support will consistently focus on the overall impact objective(s) of the Public Health Departments.

Technical Leadership (primary responsibility):

• With Vital Strategies Country Lead, lead in-country technical and capacity development including mentoring, facilitation of workshops, coaching and training, guiding and performing data analysis, producing reports and data visualizations

• Develop relationship with and serve as Initiative's primary point of contact to the Public Health Departments
