The Position

We are seeking a passionate Communications and Engagement Consultant- Breathe Jakarta specialist to lead public communications, and community outreach activities for the Breathe Jakarta program. The successful candidate will play a vital role in informing residents about air quality issues, sensitizing and engaging vulnerable populations about air quality and impacts, and facilitating community-driven clean air actions.

Duties

- Develop and implement strategies to engage key air quality from civil society organizations (CSOs), government agencies, and local communities, in the Breathe Jakarta program
- Facilitate dialogue and collaboration between government and civil society stakeholders to ensure inclusive decision-making and action planning
- Reach out to CSOs to identify opportunities for collaboration and partnership in addressing air quality challenges, with a focus on social inclusion and health equity
- Organize community forums, workshops, and other events to gather input and feedback on clean air initiatives and policies
- Build partnerships with community leaders, activists, and organizations to promote community-driven solutions to air pollution challenges
- Conduct outreach and awareness campaigns to educate residents about air quality issues and encourage participation in clean air actions

- Monitor and evaluate stakeholder engagement activities, gathering data and feedback to inform program improvements and strategic adjustments
- Assist with other Vital Strategies duties and ad hoc requests as specified by supervisor
