Across the US, health workers and community members like us are practicing harm reduction and saving lives. People who use drugs protect and improve their health with sterile syringes and safer drug-use supplies, naloxone to reverse overdose, methadone or buprenorphine treatment, nourishment, compassion, and information. Harm reduction works and must become widely available. The number of drug overdoses has exploded: more than 100,000 people in the United States died in the last year. Stigmatizing and punishing people who use drugs has only fueled the crisis. Harm reduction needs the attention, resources and policies to match the scale of the overdose crisis.
